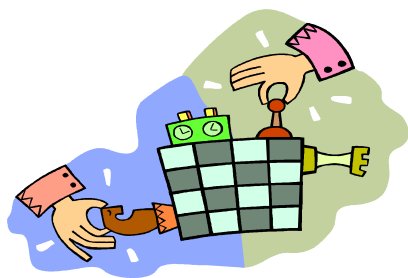

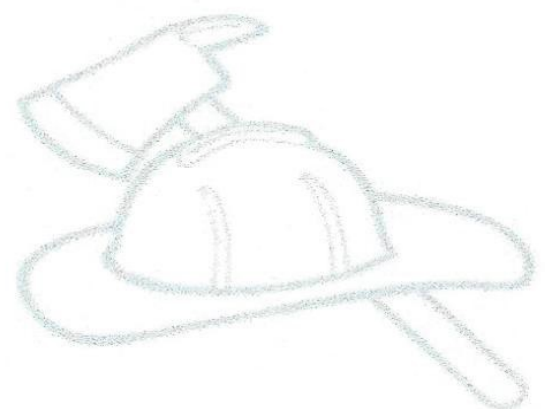

BOARD MEETING MINUTES (UNAPPROVED)
May 18, 2016

Pledge of Allegiance - Board Member John Hecker began the evening by asking the group to join him in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Call to Order – President Steve Harenberg called the meeting to order at 6:37 p.m. Board Members present were Leah Allison, Tony Baker, John Hecker, Scott Perkins, Bob Wilder, Bill Krokos, and Cathy Doss. Absent was Bo Pratt. Also present was Glenda Carlson, Acting General Manager.

Approval of Minutes – Bob Wilder made a motion to approve the April minutes with correction of the misspelling of John Hecker's last name. Leah Allison seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Finance Report – Treasurer Leah Allison reported the financial statement for April 2016 to the Board and Members present. The Finance Report was approved as presented.

Recognition of Members and Guests – In attendance were: Mike Hermann, Lot 165; Jim Richards, Lot 162; Jim Sinclair, Lot 477, Nick Schwartz, Lot 656; Glen DeLorme, Lot 1033; Kris Jouchim, Lot 116; Greg Dennis, Lot 553 and Jeff Hoerr, Lot 865.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Infrastructure - Jim Sinclair reported that the painting of the fire hydrants had been completed by Nathan Pille and his group. They look very nice and he requested the Board ask him to the next meeting to thank him and offer some sort of appreciation for a job well done. Jim stated he would have Suzanne Wheeler, who serves on the committee to contact Nathan to see if it would be possible for him to attend the next meeting (June 15th). Jim then reported on the pump room ventilation, electrical and steel door. He indicated the problem with the ground fault plug at the concession stand had been resolved. The Board asked the Committee to proceed with getting estimates for a new roof on the bath house. Please read the minutes of their meeting on Page 10 of this publication.

Land and Lakes – John Hecker reported that Land and Lakes met on May 4th and that we are waiting for the work to begin by FCI on Ravine # 9. The General Manager reported she had spoken to Mr. Terry Beckman and he indicated the area is still too wet to take equipment in there and will begin work as soon as weather allows. John reported that he had been out on one of the lakes with fellow board member, Bob Wilder and encouraged any other member that had not done so, to please try and do the same. Actual visuals help to understand some of the issues we are now addressing on the lakes. Please read the minutes of the Land and Lakes meeting on Page 11 of this publication.

Health and Environment – No Report.

Dredging Committee - Bill Krokos reported that the Committee did not meet during the month of May. Committee continues to support Land and Lakes and the Raving work, Maintenance and Operations with the Lake Treatment and Water Testing and the General Management. Future meeting will be scheduled as we progress.

Security Report – Kris Jouchim introduced Nick Schwartz to the Board and members present. Nick has been hired for the summer months to assist with security of RTA property and monitoring of boats on the lakes. The Board welcomed Nick to the RTA staff. Kris stated no activity to report on RTA property for the last month except the gathering of young adults on the upper boat ramp after hours has almost subsided after being monitored.

CLUB REPORTS

Activities Club- Cathy Doss reported that the Activities Club is still looking for volunteers for the 4th of July event (being held July 2nd). The Club agreed to purchase a new diving board for the pool. The General Manager will be getting price quotes from three companies and present them to the officers of the Activities Club for approval.

Sportsman's Club – Scott Perkins reported that the Dale Mendenhall Award will be presented to Sherry Roberts at the Fish Fry. The Fish Fry sponsored by the Sportsman's Club is being held Saturday, May 21 from 3:00-11:00. Club members were informed the bass tournament plaque hanging in the clubhouse has been updated with the names of tournament champions, \$300 was donated to the AC's last Trivia Night and the Sportsman's Club will be ordering shirts and koozies for the 4th of July festivities. The next meeting will be held June 10th at 8:00 pm

ECC -Applications: Scott Perkins

A motion was made by Cathy Doss to accept or deny all ECC applications as presented to the Board by the ECC, Bob Wilder seconded, motion carried. Accepted were Lot 70 Nofzinger- re-siding of house and garage; Lot 618 Boers- Replacement of Shed; Lot 649 Weghorst - Stamped Concrete Patio and Firepit; Lot 1001 Replace Existing Deck and Add New One. Lot 838 Jones - Place Driveway Concrete to Property Line along with neighbor doing same was asked for more information and answers before a decision could be made. Mr. Jones was asked to provide the requested information and resubmit his application for consideration.

OLD BUSINESS

Monthly Violation Reports/Update – The General Manager reported reminder letters regarding proper storage of refuse cans were sent to 22 people and that an updated lighting inspection would be presented at the next meeting. Further she reported that two written complaints of violations had been filed. **Executive Session:** Bill Krokos made a motion at 7:20 p.m. to go into executive session for discussion regarding same, Tony Baker seconded. Motion carried. Leah Allison made a motion to come out of executive session at 7:30 p.m., Tony Baker seconded. Motion carried. The manager was asked to address both issues and to report back to the board at the next meeting.

Harker's Corner/Beautification Project: The Board stated they were **very** pleased with the work Greg Dennis and Dennis Woods of the Maintenance Department had done and thanked them. Discussion was held regarding the silt fence in that area that had previously been installed by Calicotte. The Board asked Greg Dennis to go ahead and perform the maintenance and upkeep on this fencing from here forward.

FCI Culvert Repair -Ravine #9 - The General Manager reported she had spoken to Terry Beckman from FCI and he had indicated that the area is too wet and they are waiting for dryer ground before they get in there with heavy equipment. He will keep us updated on the schedule

Jaedco (Rush) Contract- Mr. Rush will be submitting a report on his finding regarding the feasibility of the 319 Grant and his visit to our lake community in April. During the month of May he will return for a second visit and bring the water bottle samples he has received for us for water training and will meet with Greg Dennis and Dennis Woods and again view the lakes. John Hecker and Bob Wilder have expressed an interest in attending, if available.

4th of July Festivities - Executive Directors signed the application for the Fireworks Display from Logan-Trivoli Fire Department. Bob Wilder asked the General Manager to get with him on obtaining the generator for the band. He may be able to provide it elsewhere at a cost savings to the association. After some discussion, the General Manager asked the Board to approve having one uniformed officer for the fourth of July event, instead of two. The Board approved. This will provide a cost savings of approximately \$300.00.

NEW BUSINESS

Pool House Ventilation - The Board reviewed the ventilation bids obtained from the ILRPC and approved Fritch Heating and Cooling, Inc in the amount of \$1,425.00. They will be asked to complete the work prior to the opening of the pool on May 28th.

Swim Team Schedule/Swim Lesson Schedule/ Water Aerobic Schedule- Cathy Doss made a motion to accept all three schedules as presented. Motion was seconded by Tony Baker. All in Favor. Motion carried.

Tree/ Brush Removal - Clubhouse Hillside - After some discussion, Cathy Doss made a motion to have maintenance cut down the tree by the beach and the locust tree on the hill. Motion was seconded by Scott Perkins. 7 Ayes, 1 Nay. Motion carried.

Fire Department /Open House- The fire department will be holding an open house of the new facility on June 5th from 2:00 - 4:00 p.m. All Members are invited to attend. The Board agreed to waive a fee for an insert or ad in the monthly newsletter going out in June.

Executive Session- Leah Allison made a motion to go into executive session at 8:15 p.m., seconded by Bill Krokos. All in Favor, Motion carried. Motion was made by Bill Krokos to come out of Executive Session at 8:35 p.m., seconded by Bob Wilder. All in Favor, Motion carried.

Action Resulting From Executive Session-NONE

Adjournment – Motion was made by Bob Wilder and seconded by John Hecker to adjourn the meeting at 8:45p.m. All in Favor, Motion carried.

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NEXT PUMP DATE _____

Minutes – Infrastructure/Long-Range Planning Committee (ILRPC)

Tuesday, May 10, 2016

Call to Order - The meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM. Committee members in attendance were Kevin Arduini, Darrel Hedman, and Jim Sinclair. Committee member absent were Suzanne Wheeler and Tony Baker (Board Liaison).

Report on the April 2016 RTA Meetings – Presented our recommendation to Board to accept the Fritch ventilation fan bid. Board conditionally accepted with follow-up regarding 1) electrical costs to ensure fan can work with building amperage and 2) obtain prices on new steel door with a louvres. Told Board that 3-phase is not an option until we replace the pumps with 3-phase pumps. Board gave okay to obtain bids for the pool house roof repairs and replacement.

Swimming Pool Complex –

Pump room ventilation electricity – Kevin Arduini worked with Greg Dennis and found a 20 amp breaker that is not being used in the pump room. The ventilation fan needs less than 2 amps. They also went over the concession area overloads and decided to replace the ground fault plug to see if this makes a difference.

Pump room doors – Darrel and Jim looked into the cost of a new commercial double steel sided door with louvres and obtained two estimates from S&S Builders Hardware (approximately\$900 with all hardware) and Trimco (approximately \$820 without tax). These were provided to Glenda for Board consideration.

Pool house roof – The committee is meeting with roofers later this week and will review the estimates at our June meeting.

Committee Projects – No Project Request Forms were presented by the community this month.

Fire hydrant painting project – The hydrants were painted and look great. We would recommend that the Board send a thank you letter to the Eagle Scout candidate.

Items not discussed – 1) 30-year planning; and 2) Old baseball field.

Minutes – Land & Lakes Committee Minutes

Wednesday, May 4, 2016

Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 6:30. In attendance were Glenda Carlson, Glen DeLorme, Lynn Gosnell, Steve Harenberg, John Hecker, Deb Metroff, & Bob Wilder. Visitor: Brandon Lohnes

Report on the April Board Meeting: Work has been completed on the Bridge and the Weir Dam.

Old Business:

- The "Camelot Beautification" project at the Harker's Corner Road entrance is near completion.
- Terry Beckman will begin work on Area #9 as soon as the weather allows.

Lake Management:


- Joe Rush was back out, and together with Greg and Dennis they have already treated the lakes. Joe went over the chemical list and has suggested some changes that could save the Association up to \$3,000. The plan is to get ahead and stay ahead with the treatments. Joe will be back to do water testing and training.
- Work on the Lake Management Plan Manual is continually progressing. John has asked for input from everyone to assist with adding pertinent history and information regarding the Lakes to the manual. He feels this will provide valuable information for future Board Members. John also suggested that we get a summary of Joe's first (and future) visit to keep on file in the Lake Management Plan Manual.

New Business:

- John would like the opportunity to take a boat tour of the Lakes.
- A request was made that the Lakes only be lowered every two years.
