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
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Ron Draper Kids Fishing Derby

Minutes - Land & Lakes Committee

Wednesday, May 7, 2014

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 6:30. Committee members in attendance were Glenda Carlson, Collin Cochran, Glen Delorme, Lynn Gosnell, Steve Harenberg, Richard Novitsky, and Bruce Whelchel. Greg Dennis was also in attendance.

Report on the April 16th Board Meeting: Steve Harenberg gave a brief report on the meeting. He stated he had informed the Board the contractor is ready to go on the siltation projects, he is just waiting for the road commissioner to life the road bans and they will get started.

Lake Treatment: Greg Dennis reported that both he and Dennis Woods had passed the required testing for lake treatment applications and are in the process of developing a treatment plan based on the information they have put together from Marine Biochemists (our former sprayer) and area chemical suppliers. He stated he would like the committee, the board and the general membership to know this year is a learning year, some of what they will be doing will be doing will be trial and error but that they have good, reliable sources that are willing to help them with any questions, concerns or recommendations as needed.

Plans for Completing Erosion Control Project Number 1 (from 2013): Collin reported that timing is everything with the pile on the hill still needing to be burned. It must be times just right with the wind blowing in the right direction. He is keeping an eye on the weather daily and will be advising when the time is right. Volunteers will be needed to keep an eye on the burn for the first 24 hours at least. The contractor we already have has agreed he would be willing to finish the final grade, the seeding and placing the straw. Weather permitting, the project should be complete by the end of the month.

Dam & Bridge Inspection Reports:

- 1. Dam Inspection Report: Greg reported the lawn care contractor has mowed the top half of the area and maintenance has filled some surface holes and seeded. Brush cutting and clearing has been performed. Monthly inspections by maintenance continues to be performed.
- 2. Bridge Inspection Report: The committee agrees that a professional opinion needs to be obtained prior to developing a plan. Bruce has talked to one professional but thought the costs for an engineering study were a little high and will take the opportunity prior to the next meeting to obtain other opinions and cost options.

Erosion Control and Siltation Projects Number 1 & 2 for 2014 (The siltation ponds at the North end of Lake Camelot and the West end of Lake Lancelot):

Steve and Bruce met with the contractor on the property to go over the details of the projects and walk the areas where the work is being performed as he has started some of the clearing. Steve will take the lead managing the project, Bruce and Collin will assist. We are still waiting on the road restrictions to be lifted which is expected to be around the middle of May. Bruce will stay in contact with the Township Road Commissioner to see if we can begin earlier. With regards to the buried phone cable that runs through the woods and under the lake in the project area near the West end of Lake Lancelot. Bruce, Glenda and Collin met with engineers from AT&T on Friday, April 4th to determine if the cable could be relocated. The engineers indicated it was plausible and were going to physically take a look, go back to their office and see what needs to be done to get this cable moved. We have not yet heard back from them with regards to this matter.

Erosion Control and Siltation for 2014:

- 1. **Removing Lake Siltation**: Bernie and Richard gave an update on the development of a plan for removing silt from our lakes. The discussion focused on the depth of siltation in the areas to be identified. Glenda is going to contact the Herman Brothers in an effort to get a copy of a report they prepared a few years ago that included some work on determining siltation depths. The committee agreed that once we determine the magnitude of the siltation and methods for controlling erosion into the lakes; we can begin to develop the best alternatives for controlling and removing the siltation.
- 2. Strategy for working with neighboring land owners (with the help of Scott Wallace and Gary Gorden from the USDA-NRCS) to control erosion into our lakes: Deb and Glenda, Deb, Steve S., will continue to work on plans for this project.
- 3. The park access area that runs between Tewksbury and Canterbury: Bernie is still working on the area as weather allows. Will need to determine if we are able to get equipment into this area.

New Business:

1. **Community Clean up Day-** Glenda reported that a Community Clean up Day has been set for June 7th with all volunteers meeting up at the Clubhouse anytime between 8:00 a.m. and Noon. The Activities Club and the Sportsman's Club will be providing pizza, snacks and treats at noon for all of those that volunteer. X-Waste will be providing a dumpster for the event. We encourage you to come out and support your community by helping to keep it clean!

EXECUTIVE SESSION - The Board went into Executive Session at 6:35 p.m. with a motion made by Lynn Johnston, seconded by Leah Allison 4-Yes 3-Nays. Bill Whitehurst made a motion, seconded by Matt Buczynski to exit Executive Session at 7:04 p.m. No Action Resulted from Executive Session.

General Discussion was held regarding the Covenants Review Committee's status regarding recommendations being made and the changes being proposed to the board along with the voting procedures. Areas concerning having fences or not having fences and boating regulations were discussed and the board informed those interested in these matters would be invited to attend the covenants review committee meeting prior to their final recommendations to the board. Committee Reports

Infrastructure – Jim Sinclair gave an updated report on the restroom renovation project in the clubhouse. He had received three bids from subcontractors with variations in selection for updates that the board will review. Further, committee is awaiting updated long term project planning report from reserve study management group. The General Manager reported this should be available by the next meeting if not before.

Land and Lakes — Steve Harenberg reported for the Land and Lakes Committee. Greg Dennis attended their meeting this month and discussed his treatment plan for spraying the lakes. The Committee is still working on the erosion control project from 2013. Burning on the hillside behind the lower dam will be completed as weather permits. Bruce Whelchel, Steve Harenberg and Collin Cochran continue to monitor the progress on these projects and report to the board as they proceed.

Health and Environment - NO REPORT

Covenant Review – Lynn Johnston reported the committee will be scheduling another meeting once they receive all changes back from the board. The last covenant review meeting will be posted at the entrance for all members to join the meeting for one-half hour at the beginning with comments and concerns.

Security Report – Brian Emhoff reported no security issues at the clubhouse complex or RTA property over the last thirty days.

Club Reports

Activities Club – Planning is still proceeding with the events for the 4th of July Celebration on the 5th. There is still a need for volunteers to work the snack shack throughout the day. Anyone interested in helping should contact Angie Robertson and/or Kristy Bushart.

Swimming Pool & Snack Bar- Fifteen Lifeguards have been hired and Five Snack Bark Workers for the 2014 Swimming Pool Season. The Snack Bar will open this year with the addition of personal pan pizzas and garlic bread.

July 5th Fireworks Celebration- The General Manager reported on the event planning process and the Board would like to encourage everybody to come and enjoy a great day! We have chosen this year a family oriented band whom interacts with the crowd and is looking to provide us, children and adults alike, with a very good time!

2013 Annual Review & Tax Return - The Annual Review and Return was received from Rotherham & Company. Reports were submitted to the Executive Board for review and the 2013 Tax Return has been submitted.

Reserve Study Progress- Update by Reserve Study Program not yet received.

Lot 706- Board will proceed with recommendation from legal counsel in an effort to recoup unpaid assessments.

Community Clean up-Day - The General Manager reported Community Clean up Day will be June 7th and the Activities and Sportsman's Club have agreed to provide pizza, snacks and Drinks. X-Waste will be donating a dumpster for the event. The Board invites all members to help!!




