Some Basic Rules to Ice Safety

NEVER just assume the ice is safe. While some people may be out on the ice does not mean the entire lake is safe. Shallow water, coves and shaded areas freeze up first. These areas may be ok to walk on while the deeper, more open water may just be covered with a thin layer of dangerous ice. One quick way to check ice thickness is to use a cordless drill with a long wood auger bit. Another is an ice chisel or "spudbar". Ice thickness can greatly vary in short distances. Check the ice about every 100 feet or so. Early or late ice require more frequent checks. There is NO such thing as "safe ice".

Here are a few:

Never go out on the ice alone. Make sure you have proper safety equipment and a buddy.

Wear a personal floatation device under your winter gear. Wear appropriate footwear. Crampons are used to convert footwear for use on ice.

Carry ice picks at all times.

Carry a rope with you.

Never walk or drive on cloudy ice.

Spring ice is NEVER safe

Snow acts as an insulator - it makes ice warmer and weaker.

Extreme cold snaps will weaken the ice.

Less than 2" - STAY OFF the ice.



CAMELOT ROUND TABLE ASSOCIATION BOARD MEETING MINUTES (UNAPPROVED) January 20, 2016

<u>Call to Order</u> – President Steve Harenberg called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m. Board Members present were Bill Krokos, Leah Allison, Tony Baker, John Hecker, Scott Perkins and Bob Wilder. Members absent was Cathy Doss and Bo Pratt. Also present was Glenda Carlson, Acting General Manager.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u> – Bill Krokos made a motion to approve the December minutes, Bob Wilder seconded. All in favor, motion carried. <u>Finance Report</u> – Treasurer Leah Allison reported the financial statement for December 2015 to the Board and Members present. The Finance Report was approved as presented.

<u>Recognition of Members and Guests</u> – In attendance were Greg Dennis, Lot 553; Glen DeLorme, Lot 1033; Kris Jouchim, Lot 715 and invited guest, Mike Bryant from Farnsworth Group whom performs our bridge and dam inspections.

Dam & Bridge Inspection/Question & Answer Session: Mike began the session with an introduction of himself as having been the person to perform the bridge and dam inspections for Lake Camelot for the last thirty (30) years, although the companies have changed themselves from Daily & Associates to Foth to the current company, Farnsworth. He stated because of his familiarity with our structures he has been able to follow the deterioration over the years and is not overly concerned with the weir dam or the current surface corrosion on the bridge. However, he recommends that we clean off and apply and epoxy on the weir and break off loose concrete, clean rust off and paint the surface corrosion underneath the bridge to extend the life of the structure. Further, recommends we to continue to budget for major repairs and/or replacement of that structure, along with the dams and spillways within the next five to ten year which are estimated to cost in excess of \$100,000.00 each. The question was asked if he had an y knowledge of the water intake valve on the upper lake which has visible deterioration (that the water company nor the association could locate any plans for) and we had instructed maintenance to repair. Mr. Bryant indicated that his company once all the plans are forwarded from Foth may be able to locate plans but that he is familiar with this vessel and knows that it does not serve any current purpose and recommends that there is no need for repair. Having asked Mr. Bryant several questions and discussed his recommendations, the Board thanked him for his valuable information and attendance at this meeting.

Dredging Committee-Bill Krokos reported the last meeting of the dredging committee was held on January 14th with 9 member present, 6 Board/Committee Members and 2 Community Members. Bill submitted a list of current members of the Dredging Committee to the Board for approval. Leah Allison made a motion to approve, John Hecker seconded. All in favor. Further, Bill informed the board that Bo Pratt has been appointed to take over the Dredging Page on the Association's official Webpage and that all installs have been completed for him to start doing so. Update was given on the ravine inspection- The General Manager stated the report has been received, copies were handed out to the Board President, one to Land and Lakes and one to the Dredging Committee. Additional copies are available at the office if other members would like to take them on loan to review. Committee requested the Board asked Mr. Schafer from the Illinois Surveying and Consulting firm, whom prepared the report, to attend the next Land and Lakes meeting on February 3, 2016. The Board instructed management to extend an invitation to Mr. Shafer to attend that meeting. Bill thanked everyone who came to their meeting and continues to look for more member attendance and community support.

Water Intake Valve Repairs/Upper Lake Update- Maintenance is waiting for water levels to lower to complete the needed repairs.

Monthly Violation Reports/Update – Management indicated there are some boats, trailers and recreational vehicles still not in compliance with the rules regarding parking. They have been notified- some by the County, some by placement of notice in the newsletter or gentle reminders sent to their homes. The violation fine structure called for 1st notice of a fine in the amount of \$25.00 to be sent. The Board instructed Management to send out 1st offense fines to those Members still not incompliance with parking r rules regarding boats, trailers and recreational vehicles.

Repair Updates/Culvert(s)-Logan Township- Bill Krokos reported that FCI has delivered materials and will begin work weather permitting...

<u>Armature/Pool Pump & Motors-</u> Bill Krokos made a motion to approve the estimate for repairs of the pool pumps and motors received from Armature Pump & Motor in the amount of \$\$5,397.50, Bob Wilder seconded. All in Favor, Motion carried.

DAM INSPECTION REPORT: A motion was made by John Hecker, seconded by Tony Baker to approve the reports as submitted on the dams & bridge by Farnsworth Group. Further, it was agreed as recommended, to clean and paint the underside of the bridge, clean, repair and overlay damaged areas of the weir dam, All in Favor, Motion Carried. Scott Perkins agreed to provide scope of work so bids may be obtained from three outside contractors.

WINTER BLOOD DRIVE: The Winter Blood Drive held on January 18th was successful and we met the goal set for our community! A BIG thanks to all of those that came out! The next community blood drive will be held in July, 2016!

DREDGING COMMITTEE MINUTES

Date: January 14, 2016 Time: 6:00 P.M.

Location: Lake Camelot Clubhouse

Attending: Dredging Committee Chairman, Bill Krokos, General Manager Glenda Carlson Dredging Committee Members: Cathy and Mike Molchin, John Hecker and Jim Tilhoff

Chairman Krokos introduced the members of the committee and welcomed visitors to the meeting.

Chairman Krokos reviewed the accomplishments of the dredge committee as presented to the community at the annual meeting held in December 2015.

Chairman Krokos presented an updated committee member list for 2016.

Chairman Krokos presented an update on board approved dredging committee expenditures, including a 319 Grant feasibility study, water testing and Aquatic training and a professional survey and study of the lake ravines (source of sedimentation).

Chairman Krokos reviewed the complexity of a dredging operation and the need for a suitable location to pump sediment close to the lakes. The RTA board has given Krokos and RTA Board Chairman Steve Harenberg authority to discuss possible land purchases for a dewatering basin. Discussions have already taken place and continue with adjacent private property owners.

Chairman Krokos updated the committee and visitors on the status of the dredging committee website as well as the results of the most Recent 2015 questionnaire to Lake Camelot members.

Other items that were discussed as a result of questions from the committee members and the visitors included:

Estimated cost for land to provide for the dewatering basin

Alternative sites for the dewatering basin

Feasibility of successfully securing any grants available for lake improvement projects


The need for an overall lake management plan as well as a comprehensive plan including all infrastructure needs such as swimming pool capital upgrades, dam and bridge improvements, tennis court surfacing, clubhouse improvements, etc.

The importance of effectively communicating with community members as to the need to take care of the community assets as well as funding options.

NEXT STEPS: Update existing Lake Management Plan with consultant report on Water Testing, 319 Grant Feasibility Study and Ravine Study




