



Minutes – Infrastructure/Long-Range Planning Committee (ILRPC)

Tuesday, November 10, 2015

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM. Committee members in attendance were Suzanne Wheeler, Jim Sinclair, and Darrel Hedman. Committee members absent were Kevin Arduini and Matt Buczynski.

Report on the October 21st Board Meeting: Suzanne presented the committee report. No additional guidance came from the Board.

Asset Listing/Reserve Study – Tabled until next meeting. At this point, the Club House, Bath House, maintenance shed, and docks on both lakes will be the main focus of the committee. However, we will obtain any quotes obtained over the last few years from the RTA office to help fill in the estimates below. Some of these have been added.

Committee Projects – No Project Request Forms were presented by the community this month.

Old Baseball Field - The committee has a few other members who have come forward to help clean up this area by removing the old poles and fencing. We decided to postpone this until the spring.

Fire Hydrants – The Eagle Scout project has been postponed until the spring. The Eagle candidate from Glasford will lead a group of adults and youth to clean and paint the community fire hydrants at that point.

30-Year Planning project: The committee would suggest that the Board and Committee chairs meet twice a year to focus on community planning. **Goal for 2015:** Create the 30-year planning document with estimates for the next two years obtained.

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CAMELOT ROUND TABLE ASSOCIATION BOARD MEETING MINUTES (UNAPPROVED) November 18, 2015

<u>Call to Order</u> – President Steve Harenberg called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Board Members present were Gary Smith, Brian Woertz, Cathy Doss, Bill Krokos, Matt Buczynski and Leah Allison, Jake Gelhausen and Bo Pratt. Also present was Glenda Carlson, General Manager. <u>Approval of Minutes</u> – Brian Woertz made a motion to approve the October minutes, Jake Gelhausen seconded. All in favor, motion carried. <u>Finance Report</u> – Treasurer Leah Allison reported the financial statement for October, 2015 to the Board and Members present. The Finance Report was approved as presented.

<u>Recognition of Members and Guests</u> – In attendance were Don Thompson, Lot 405; Jim Sinclair, Lot 477; Bob Wilder, Lot 122; Brandon Lohnes, Lot 22; Greg Dennis, Lot 553; Terry Merrick, Lot 499; Gordon Young, Lot 200; Janice Bonneville, Lot 555; and Kris Jouchim, Lot 116.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

<u>Infrastructure</u> - Jim Sinclair reported that volunteers will be called in the spring to help tear down the fence at the old ball diamond that was approved to be removed at the last board meeting. He recommended that Chairpersons for Committees get together at a meeting possibly two times a year and with the Board to talk about projects that need to be worked on throughout the year. Please see minutes of meeting in this publication.

Land and Lakes – Steve Harenberg reported that at the meeting old business was discussed along with the items needed to be put on the 2015 Annual Report which will be submitted to present at the annual meeting on December 6th. Bill Krokos and Jake Gelhausen, from the Dredging Committee, were also in attendance to request the Land and Lakes Committee support a proposal being made to the Board of Directors for three items involving Lake Management and Planning. Please refer to minutes of meeting in this publication.

Health and Environment – No Report.

Dredging Committee- Bill Krokos reported that their November 12th meeting had been cancelled due to illnesses. He presented the Board with a request to approve the following on behalf of this Committee and endorsement from the Land and Lakes: 1) A **319 Grant Feasibility Study**: Cost approx **\$600-700**. Necessary to determine if we are eligible to receive federal grant money possibly saving us thousands of dollars in the upcoming costs of ravine work and erosion control. **Water Testing and Aquatic Training**: Cost **\$6,000.00 ea=\$12,000.00**. Needed to perform a base line and properly train staff to do testing and aquatic weed identification and treatment. **Professional Survey/Study of Ravines**: Cost **\$6,000.00** A consultant and his survey team to walk 25+ ravines and assess condition, make recommendations for repair and sustainability options. This is necessary for the future protection of our lakes. These proposals , along with the **\$4,100.00** approved at last month's meeting for the repairs to the culvert area near Lots 298/299 and 300, would total approximately **\$22,900.00**. Funds for all these projects would come out of the dredging and erosion control accounts which at years end would contain \$25000+. Bill Krokos made a motion to approve these proposals as submitted, Gary Smith seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

<u>Nominating Committee -</u> Don Thompson reported that there are 6 people running for the 5 open positions. Return Ballots are available to be received in the mail or at the office until noon the day of the meeting, Sunday, December 6th. Ballot counters for the election have been confirmed and they are Meg Ray, Kathy Novitsky and Marcy Lowe. Results of the count will be given at the Annual Meeting.

<u>Security Report</u> – Our security guard, Kris Jouchim, was present at the meeting and stated no instances of security issues to report from the last thirty days. He has been present, at the request of our Activities Club Directors, at their monthly dances. There too, no reports of any disturbances or issues to report at this time.

CLUB REPORTS

<u>Activities Club</u>- Cathy Doss reported that the Santa Breakfast is December 5th from 8:00-11:00 a.m. The Game Day people are running the event again this year. No Activities Club meeting will be held in December. At the next meeting in January the committee will elect new officers. The next Trivia night is January 22, 2015. Please check out their page in this newsletter.

<u>Sportsman's Club</u> –New Year's Eve tickets will go on sale at the Lake Camelot office December lst. The Club participated in the cost of the delivery of 1200+ walleye in the lakes this year in the amount of \$800.00 They will not be doing the work on the upper boat ramp until spring. Brian Woertz will serve as Board Liaison with the Sportsman's Club for the month of December. After such time, a new liaison will be appointed when the new Board is seated.

TABLED ITEMS

Reserve/Replacement Study

ECC- Applications

Cathy Doss reported an emergency application had been approved by e-mail for Lots 637 and 639 for drainage tile repair. Motion had been made by Brian Woertz to approve, seconded by Matt Buczynski. Motion unanimously carried. Matt Buczynski made a motion, seconded by Bo Pratt to accept all of the ECC recommendations as submitted at this meeting. All in Favor, Motion Carried. They were as follows: Stender, Lot 78/79-Replacing Deck with Sunroom; Duncan, Lot 284-Applying for Contiguous Lot Status; Merrick, Lot 499-Dredging Out Lake Front; Musil,

Lot 707/708-Applying For Contiguous Lot Status. All Approved as Submitted.

OLD BUSINESS

<u>Water Intake Valve Repairs/Upper Lake Update-</u> Greg Dennis, & Dennis Woods have reviewed the water intake valve & will be preparing to make the necessary repairs as the lakes have now been lowered.

<u>Monthly Violation Reports/Update</u> – Management reported second fines as allowed within the Lake Camelot fine structure have not been sent out to initial violators whom received \$25.00 fines and have not yet paid. The Board instructed management to send the additional fines out as permitted. A third written complaint was received by the office with regards to improper parking and obstructing the flow of traffic by Lot 563. Two previous fines have been send and paid and the third is a \$100 fine with the next to be loss of association privileges for up to one (1) year. Jake Gelhausen, seconded by Matt Buczynski made a motion to send out the third fine notice on the parking violation. Roll Call Vote: Gary Smith-no; Brian Woertz-no; Leah Allison-yes; Jake Gelhausen-yes; Steve Harenberg-yes; Cathy Doss-yes; Matt Buczynski-yes; Bo Pratt-yes; and Bill Krokos - abstained. Motion carried.

<u>Repair Updates/Culvert(s)-Logan Township-</u> Management had received four (4) bids for the repairs to the culvert at Lots 298/299 and Lots 300. The Board unanimously approved the bid from FCI Excavating in the amount of \$4,100.00. Management was asked to inform FCI of this approval, obtain a certificate of insurance and ask for materials to be ordered so the work may be completed as soon as the weather permits.

<u>Armature/Pool Pump & Motors-</u> An estimate to repair and /or replace the two motors/pumps we currently have are in excess of \$5,000.00. Management reported we are awaiting an additional pricing information from another supplier before a decision is made to proceed.

<u>Pool Pit/Wall/Metal Insert Cost Proposal Bid-</u> Received one bid in the amount of \$2,800 + and \$440 to replace a 4" pipe in the pit that is corroded and also needs to be replaced. Management reported additional pricing information is also needed on these two items before a decision can be made. They hope to have comparative costs by the next meeting.

<u>Snow Blower/Estimates For Purchase-</u> Tabled: Maintenance has requested we not purchase an additional snow blower at this time but to continue to look for a used truck with a plow.

NEW BUSINESS:



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
