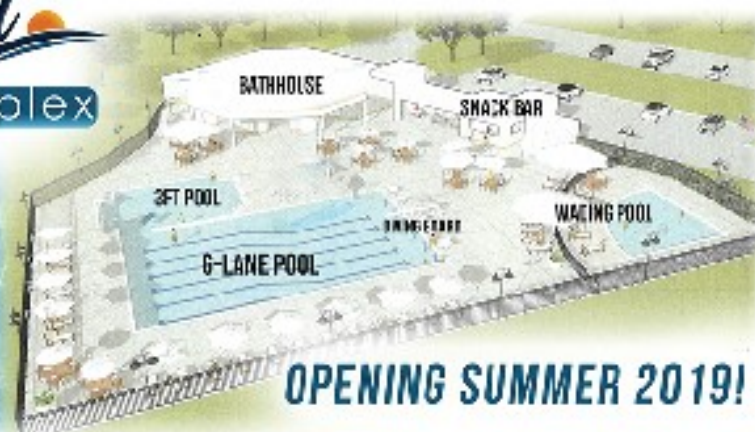

### General Manager's Report by Daryl Johnson

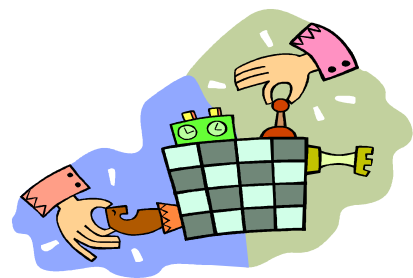
I hope everyone made it through the arctic blast without incident! Just a reminder, Spring is less than two months away!!

Board Meeting Minutes  
(Unapproved)

**Pledge of Allegiance** - President, Chris Mackesy asked the audience to please stand and join the board of directors in saying the pledge of allegiance.

**Confirmation of Quorum** – Chris Mackesy confirmed a Quorum was present.

**Call to Order** – Chris Mackesy called the meeting to order at 6:33 p.m. Board Members Present: Chris Mackesy, Adam Gillies, Dennis Ryza, Keith Lang, Terese Burdette, Ryan Millinger. Members Absent: Paul Weghorst, Jeff Dunn. Arriving mid-meeting: Shaun Howard. Chris gave congratulations to Paul for his new son, Joesph Adler.

**Approval of Board Minutes** – Motion was made by Adam and seconded by Ryan, to approve the Minutes from the December 19, 2018 Board Meeting. Motion passed.

**Finance Report** – Terese presented a report regarding the current status of the finances and accounts balances.

**Recognition of Members and Guests** – The original roster of members in attendance is available at the RTA Office.

**Committee Reports**

ILRPC –No report as Paul absent due to new baby.

Land and Lakes – Report provided by Dennis. Dennis restated that shoreline stabilization must be complete by April 1, 2021 and Hank recommended not stabilizing cove shorelines until after dredging was complete because of the risk of the shoreline sliding. He recommended adding aquatic vegetation to prevent erosion until dredging was completed. The more acres that are stabilized, the less expensive it will be per household. Hank Sutton can complete in 3-4 weeks. We’ve received one formal bid for \$5,600 from Farnsworth, to evaluate shorelines, and others have quoted about \$10k. Morinstuts would not want to do the work until dredging is complete. Will get more stabilization questions answered at the ILAC convention. Community member Collin Cochran said “Individuals have elected the board to make a decision. Least expensive, someone who’s an expert, and approved by the board. Must make sure all homes are compliant.” Land and Lakes will come up with a recommendation to the board.

Health and Environment – No Report

Fundraising – Report provided by Terese. Raised over \$835 w Avantis and Papa Murphy’s sales. Jan 23 chicken dinner with silent auction. Money raised for capital, possibly for dredging or some other funds. Collin Cochran would like to donate fishing equipment to the auction.

Swimming Pool Committee – Report provided by Keith. Next steps Pool Committee include: hiring a Pool Manager by March 1. Pool Manager would be tasked with hiring an assistant manager, head guard, life guards and concession workers by end of March / mid April. Daryl will be giving input and recommendations to the committee of who to hire. Committee will propose hours of the pool and concessions based on the survey conducted in 2018. Need to get rules, signage, and other pool accessories ordered.

Security Report – No report

**Club Reports**

Activities Club – Report provided by Chris. Ended 2018 with approximately \$10k in account, most income coming from the dances. Need supervision volunteers. Makes about \$500/mon. Kids are well-behaved, 2-hour commitment, need volunteers.

Sportsman’s Club – Report provided by Ryan. Ice fishing tournament looking like good ice due to cold weather in the next 10 days. Tournament will be Jan 26 at 7am-noon with backup date Feb 9. Tackle swap Feb 16 headed by Brian Turner, already 21 tables (only 24 max).

**ECC Recommendations** – Discussion on the pending ECC Applications held.

Lot 768 & 769 – Motion made by Adam, seconded by Terese, to deny the ECC Application to deny request retro-active before Jan 1, 2019 . Motion Passed.

Lot 903-906 – Motion made by Adam, seconded by Terese, to deny EC Application. Motion Passed.

Sportsman Club – Motion made by Adam, seconded by \_Dennis, to approve the Sportsman’s Club request to put up a temporary sign for the upcoming Ice Fishing Tournament put up Jan 25-26, Removed on the 27th. Motion Passed.


4x4 Tackle Swap sign Motion by Adam, seconded by Ryan. Motion passed.

Lot 408 – Motion made by Adam, seconded by Ryan, to deny request to return \$300 building fee since he is no longer building home. Motion passed. Dennis and Keith oppose. For future cases, we need to know what’s on the document (i.e. does it say ‘non-refundable’)

**Old Business**

New Swimming Pool Update – Report provided by Chris Mackesy. Regarding cracks in the concrete of the pool, Chris spoke to the pool subcontractor, and they say it is guaranteed to crack, but have a process to repair all the cracks. Cracks are ground down, filled, water-proof barrier added and plastered. They guarantee it will handed to our satisfaction. Information will be put in the newsletter. Chris requested written procedure to make sure we can check if they are following it correctly. To begin finishing the pool, we need three weeks of weather above 40 degrees. Need to complete fencing, as original subcontractor passed away. Completion of fence due in spring.

ACM Management Update – Report provided by Daryl. In process of switching everything over to GenArc for payments. Dues assessments should go out in the next week. Dues assessment will be mailed out Feb 1, due by March 1. Motion made by Terese, , seconded by Adam to move \$31k from our Operating Account of Glasford bank to ACM account. Motion passed.



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



The Lake Camelot Board has asked the Land and Lakes Committee to determine a method of determining who is not yet in compliance with the upcoming Shoreline Stabilization Mandate adopted in January, 2015, which lake front property owners are required to be compliance by Spring of 2020.

While the Upper lake (Lake Camelot) ‘Preliminary’ report/map on the left was prepared by a highly experienced contractor specializing in Rip Rap stabilization, the Board felt we needed an impartial engineering firm to give validation to Hank Sutton’s recommendations; as well as, providing an additional, impartial report on what Shoreline Stabilization is still needed on the Lower lake. (Lake Lancelot)

Please take some time to review the map and determine if your shoreline will require any work in the near future to be in compliance with the mandate below.

## Shoreline Stabilization Requirements — Courtesy reminder of upcoming mandate

In January 2015, the RTA board of directors approved a policy that requires all lakefront property owners to stabilize their shoreline by 2020.

Why is this important?  
To improve and maintain lake water quality by reducing soil erosion and storm water contaminants run-off into our lakes.

What shoreline stabilization methods and materials are considered acceptable?  
Generally speaking approved materials include:  
Rip Rap (Stone)  
Formed Concrete  
Green Treated Timbers  
Native Plantings  
To a great extent the topography of your shoreline will determine the stabilization method and materials to be used on your site.

What steps should I take to get started?  
#1. Think about how you currently use your shoreline or plan to use your shoreline in the future.  
#2. Consult with a contractor who has experience in shoreline stabilization to determine your specific site requirements based on shoreline slope, construction access, soil conditions, location of trees, septic system etc.  
#3. Develop a design plan based on your use expectations, site characteristics and budget. Present the plan to the ECC committee through the RTA general manager prior to purchasing materials or contracting with a general contractor.

Note: it is highly recommended to present your plans to the ECC committee at least 90 days in advance of your proposed construction schedule.

RESOLUTION OF SPECIFICATIONS FOR SHORELINE STABILIZATION REQUIREMENTS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS 12/21/16 AS FOLLOWS:

Prohibited Materials for new Shoreline Stabilization:  
Creosote Soaked Railroad Ties or Timbers  
Stainless Steel

Shoreline Slope: If less than a 25-degree (4 run/1 rise) and 34 degrees (3 run/1 rise)  
RIP RAP\* IS REQUIRED (owner may choose to utilize a sea wall)  
\*Rip Rap will extend from the bottom of the lake to no less than 2 feet above normal lake level. (6-12 inch on Lake Lancelot and 3-6 inch on Lake Camelot)

Geotextile fabric will be utilized under Rip Rap.

If shoreline slope is greater than 34 degrees...A SEA WALL\* is needed to bring the corresponding shoreline to a (4 run/1 rise) standard with vegetative erosion control incorporated.

All Sea Walls shall have suitable footings and utilize a minimum of 1-inch weep holes located 1 foot above normal water level no more than 10 feet apart.

Sea Walls shall:  
1. Be back filled with dirt to a maximum of 3 inches from weep holes with 2-3 inch rock utilized to bring to grade or top of wall.  
2. Have Rip Rap placed on the bottom of the lake to 1 foot below the normal water level at a 45-degree angle as to dissipate wave energy.  
Other energy dissipation sea wall designs will be considered on an individual basis by the ECC committee.  
Shorelines with heavy natural vegetation in place will be reviewed individually by the ECC committee to determine if further stabilization methods will be necessary.

Resolution was Adopted by the Camelot Round Table Board of Directors at a monthly meeting of the Directors on this 21<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2016.

*Illini Bluffs Kindergarten Round-Up*

Illini Bluffs Unit District #327 wants to welcome parents of incoming kindergarten students to our Kindergarten round-up. It will be held **Saturday, March 2nd from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.** in our elementary commons. Any child who will be 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2019 will be eligible to start Kindergarten. Any current Bright Futures students who are already at Illini Bluffs do not need to come. These students will be screened at school.

Students will go through a screening process on the day of registration to help our Kindergarten teachers become familiar with each child's abilities. The screening process should take approximately 20-30 minutes.

If this is your first child entering our school district, we will need you to bring **proof of residency**. It will not be needed if you already have a child in our district. We also need you to bring a **certified birth certificate**. **Certified birth certificates are available from the courthouse or health department** from the county your child was born in. The "footprint" copy from the hospital cannot be used for this purpose. If you have any questions feel free to contact Illini Bluffs Elementary office at 389-5025.

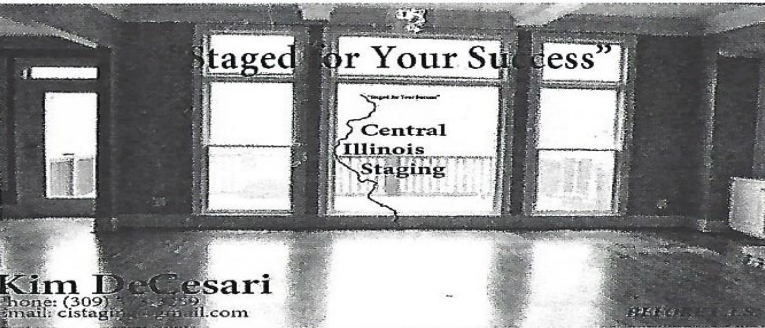
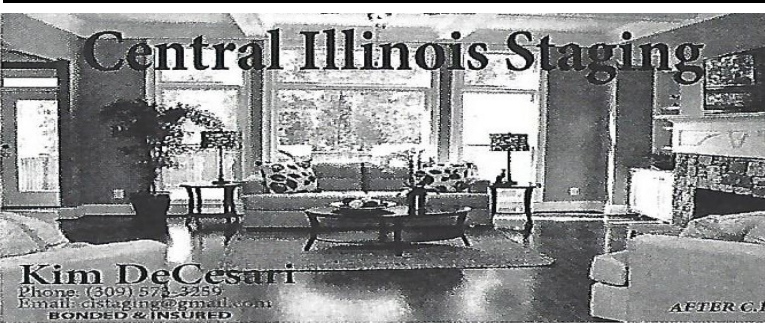
For Kindergarten your child will need the following:

- A physical exam due by the **October 1st, 2019** (with lead screening and proof of immunizations).
- An eye exam due by **October 1st, 2019** (MUST be performed by an optometrist and submitted on the State of Illinois Examination Report).
- A dental exam due by **May 15th, 2020**.

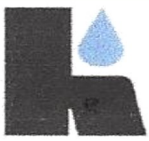
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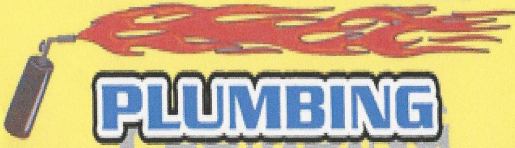

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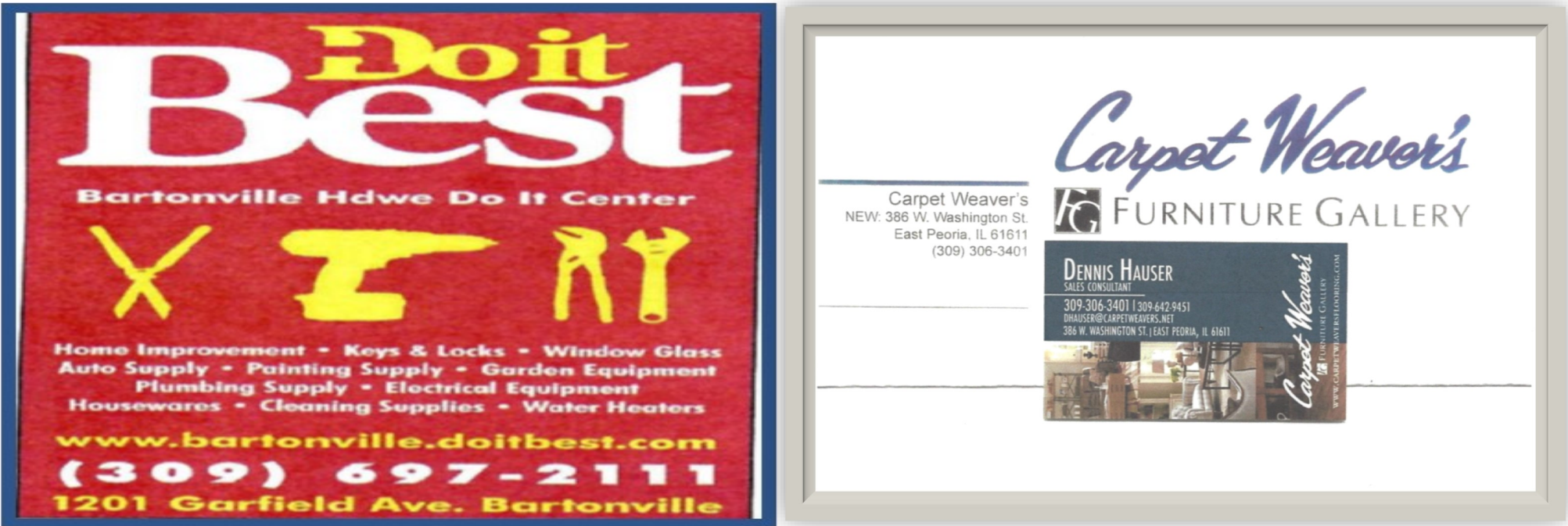
